Dear SWIBU Friends, Donators, Godmothers and Fathers

We from SWIBU, the teachers, school management and children of the APID Elementary School are on the top of the world to inform you, that your generous Donations have been finally arrived and on the 2nd of August 2019 distributed to the ones in desperate need. We can still hardly believe it and are thankful and full of happiness, that you with your golden hearts for poor people have richly blessed us.

But step by step. On the 6th of June 2019 the vessel with "our" Container has arrived in the port of Cebu and a story of a very special kind started. Thanks to large experiences in importing goods by sea, we have been professionally prepared for the arrival of the container, means all papers and documents were in our opinion perfectly prepared. However, each new day new demands of documents came from the authorities. In total 28 more documents, which had to be in triple execution and notarized, robbed us of energy, time, money and confidence that the container will be released in a foreseeable future. The lowest point was achieved, when the Head Custom Office in Manila was not able for 2 weeks to contact the APID Elementary School, means the recipient of the donations. The decision maker was incapable to type the right Email-Address from Apid School in his Email to demand further documents. We from SWIBU took all the necessary steps to put a quick end to this incapability, which again cost all of us a lot of time and energy and we worked days and nights. Due to this unprofessionalism all the costs went up for storage of the container, demurrage etc. and no end was in sight.

We were finally ready to give up this container, means to abandon it. Our Ellen P Ramas (President), Ma. Rowena P. Paran (Principal APID Elementry School) Jocelyn P. Mara-at (Teacher) and Lilliane Faye A. Rosit (Teacher) held on the last straw and asked for an audience with the governor of Cebu, which has been granted and the Head Officer of Custom has been ordered to the Governor's office. Shortly afterwards the GST and Duty have been abolished. Next steps were the begging and fight for the release of the storage and the demurrage, which in the meantime were as high as several thousands of Dollars. The SWIBU account in Switzerland was at the time nearly empty. Another two weeks long fight occurred, where the Shipper Yangming was not very cooperative and reduced the demurrage only instead of abolish it. All these robbed our committed Ladies a lot time and the believe in a good end. It remained only, that finally justice triumphed.

At the 31st of July 2019, at Midnight, it was then the time we could get the Container. Tears of happiness and relieve were flowing, finally to reach the target.

The documents fill a complete folder. We provide you with these, on request.
